- Connacht hockey believes that parents should:
 - Be a role model for your child and maintain the highest standards of conduct when interacting with young people, other parents, officials, supporters and organisers
 - Always behave responsibly and do not seek to unfairly affect the outcome of a game, a player or the opponent
 - Never intentionally expose any young participant to embarrassment or disparagement by the use of foul/abusive language or remarks
 - Recognise and support the value and importance of volunteering which provides sporting opportunities for your child
 - Respects all personnel within the Hockey club/organisation including coaches, managers, umpires, youth organisers etc...
 - Encourage your child to at all times play by the rules and to respect the spirit of fair play
 - Encourage participation and good sportsmanship
 - Take an interest in your child's sport and support your child's sporting endeavours and participation
 - Support all efforts not to tolerate foul or abusive language/behaviour such as bullying or intimidation

- Parents Code of Conduct:
 - Respect the rules and procedures set down within the club/organisation
 - Encourage and support participation and accomplishments
 - Respect team coaches and managers
 - Respect the officials and their authority at all times
 - Never demonstrate abusive/threatening behaviour or language
